1 Introduction

SK hynix Drive Manager Easy Kit is intended to provide users with detailed information on SSDs (mainly SK hynix drives), update firmware, erase drives, generate drive performance reports, and monitor drives.)

This document provides instructions on how to install/uninstall and launch SK hynix Drive Manager Easy Kit on Windows in a standard mode.

Before installing SK hynix Drive Manager Easy Kit, check whether your system meets the requirements.

2 Requirements

Drives	SK hynix Drive Manager Easy Kit supports all SSDs and HDDs but all features are available only for SK hynix SSDs.

Note : Administrator access privileges are required for installing and accessing SK hynix Drive Manager Easy Kit.

3 Standard Installation

This section provides standard installation instructions for SK hynix Drive Manager Easy Kit in the Windows environment. The installation package installs both GUI and CLI versions.

3.1 Run the setup File

To run the setup file with administrator's permission, click the setup file, and in the pop-up window, select **Run as administrator**.

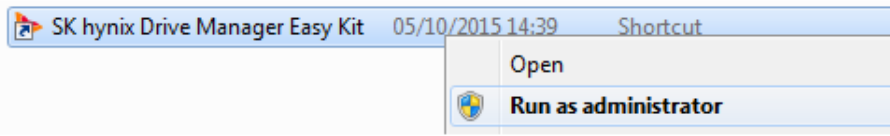


Figure 1 **Run as administrator**

3.2 Start the Installation

To start the installation process, click **Next** when the **Setup** dialog appears.

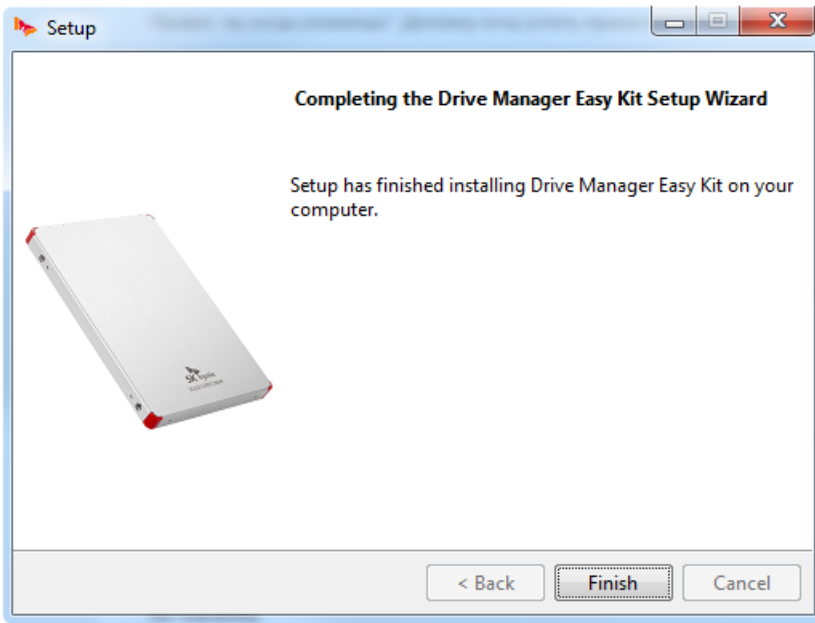


Figure 2 **Setup Screen**

3.3 Accept the License Agreement

Read the License Agreement, and to continue the installation, select **I accept the agreement**, and then click **Next**.

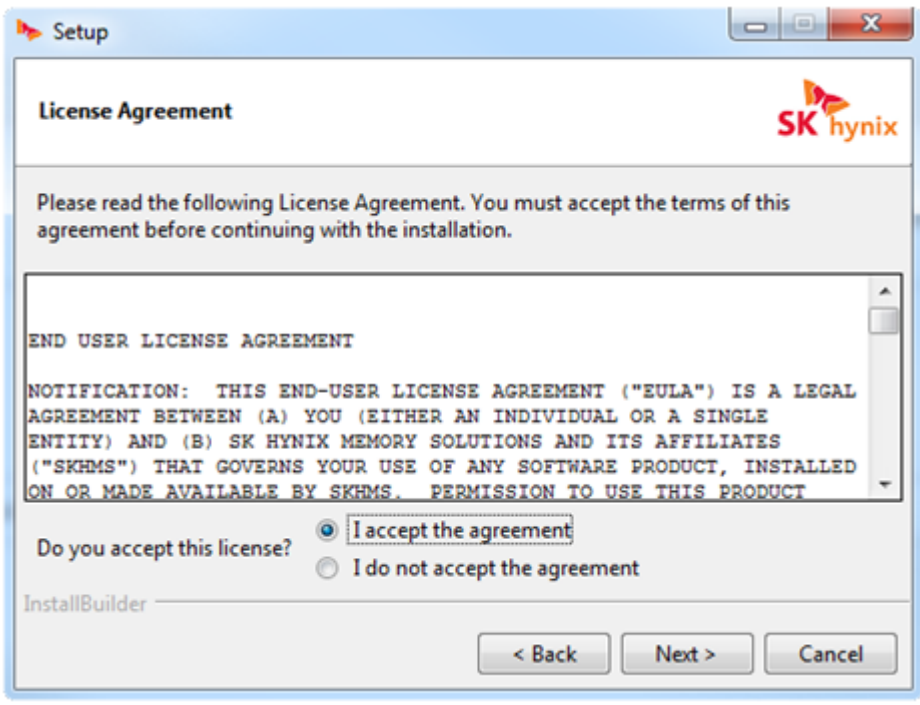


Figure 3 License Agreement

3.4 Select the Installation Directory

To select the installation directory:

- Click **Next** to install the application into the default directory *C:\Program Files\SKhynix\DriveManager*

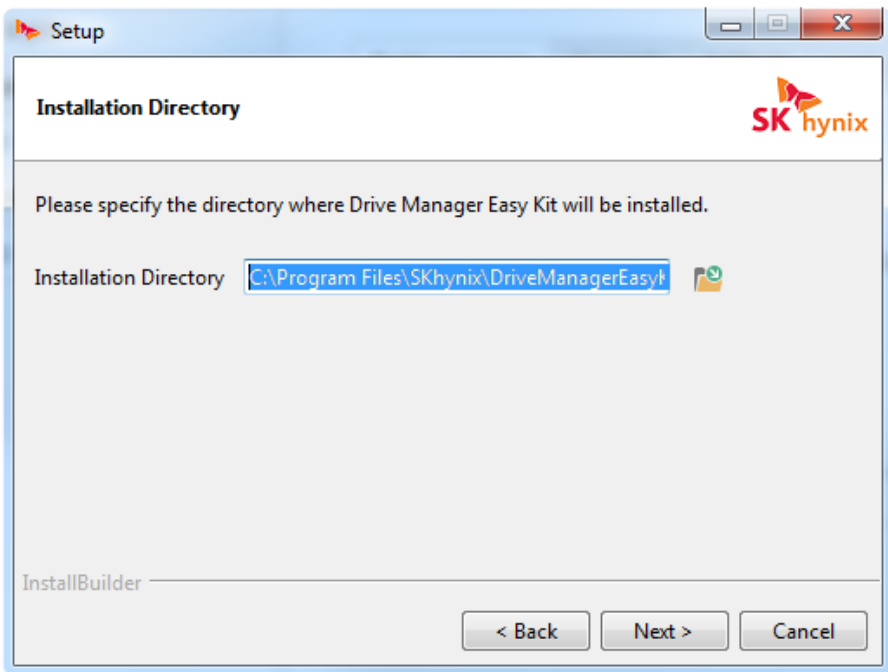


Figure 4 Installation Directory

or

- In the **Installation Directory** field, enter the required directory, and then click **Next**.

or

- Click the browse button, and in the **Browse for Folder** dialog, select the folder for the application to be installed in, and click **OK**.

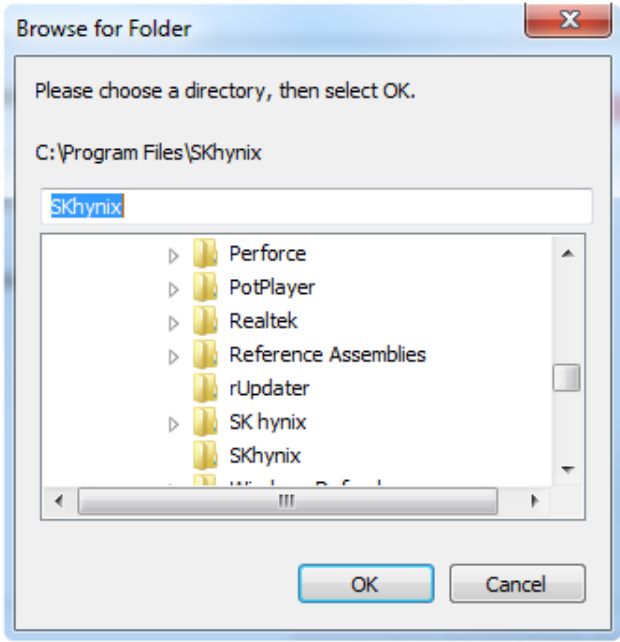


Figure 5 Browse for Folder

In the **Installation Directory** window, click **Next** to proceed.

3.5 Select Components

To install the CLI version together with GUI, select the **Command line interface** checkbox:

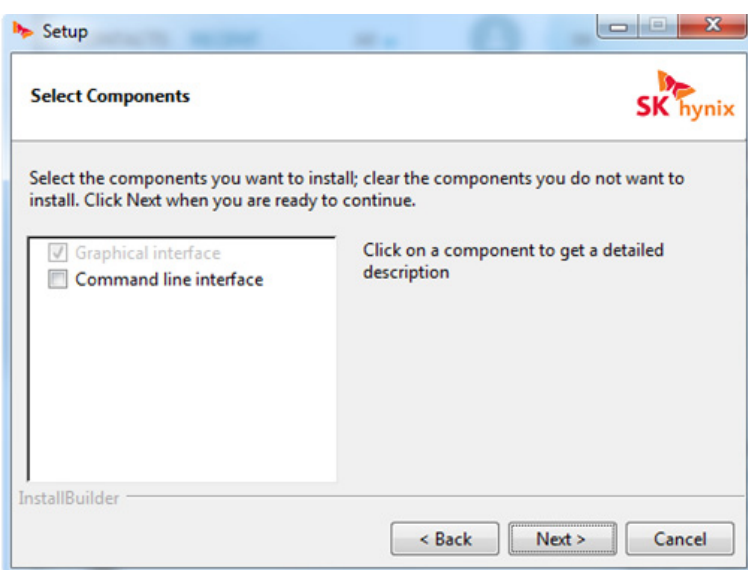


Figure 6 Select Components

Click **Next**.

3.6 Confirm the Installation

When the **Ready to Install** window appears, click **Next**.

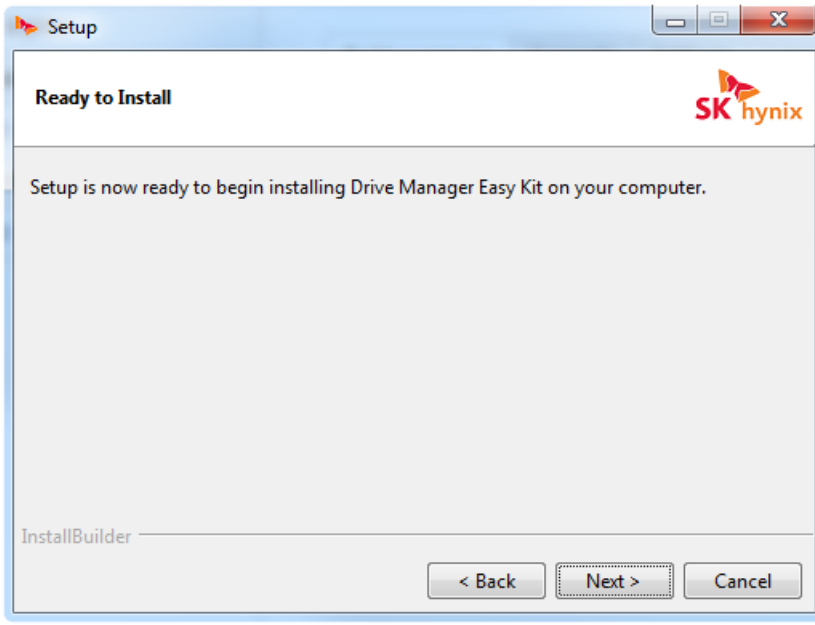


Figure 7 **Ready to Install**

3.7 View the Installation Progress

The installation progress will be shown, as in the image below:

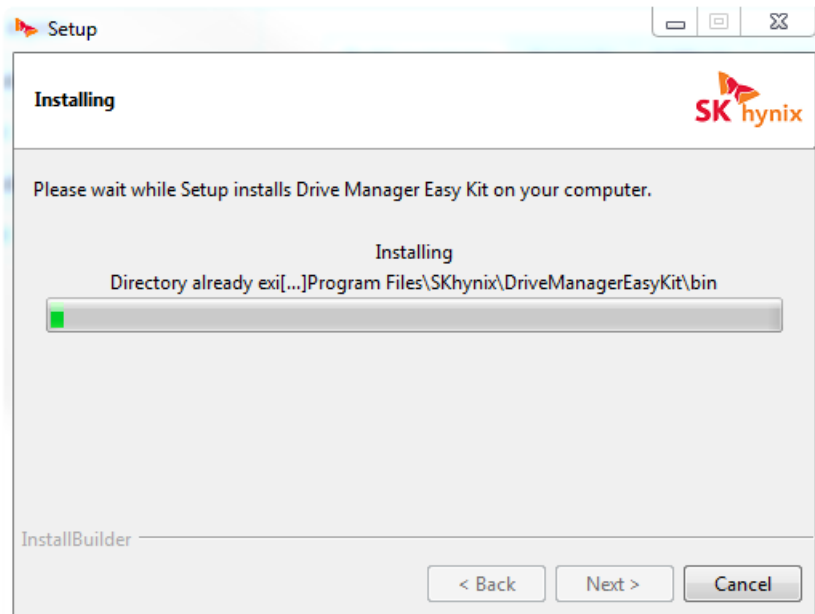


Figure 8 **Installation Progress**

Note : During the installation, the previous version of Drive Manager Easy Kit is automatically uninstalled.

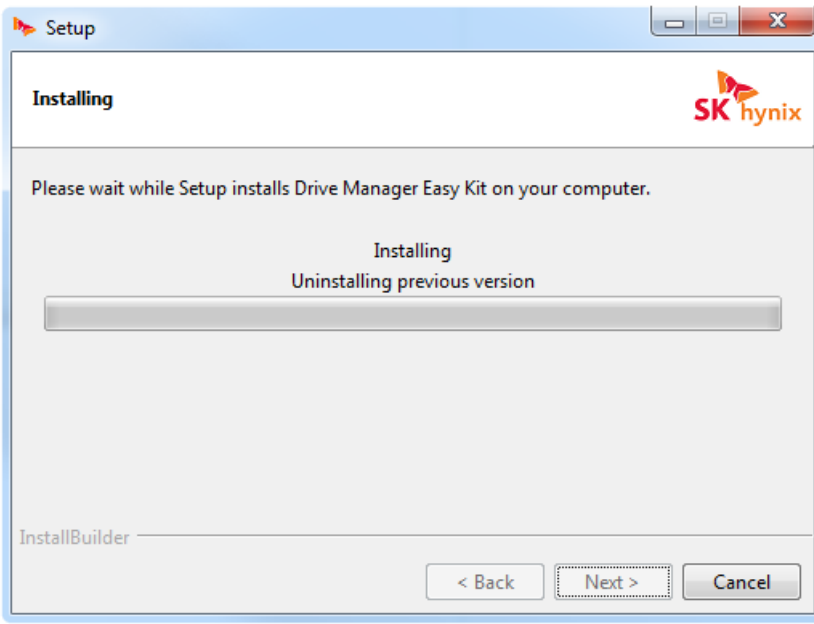


Figure 9 **Uninstalling the Previous Version**

3.8 Finish the Installation Process

When the installation is completed, click **Finish**.

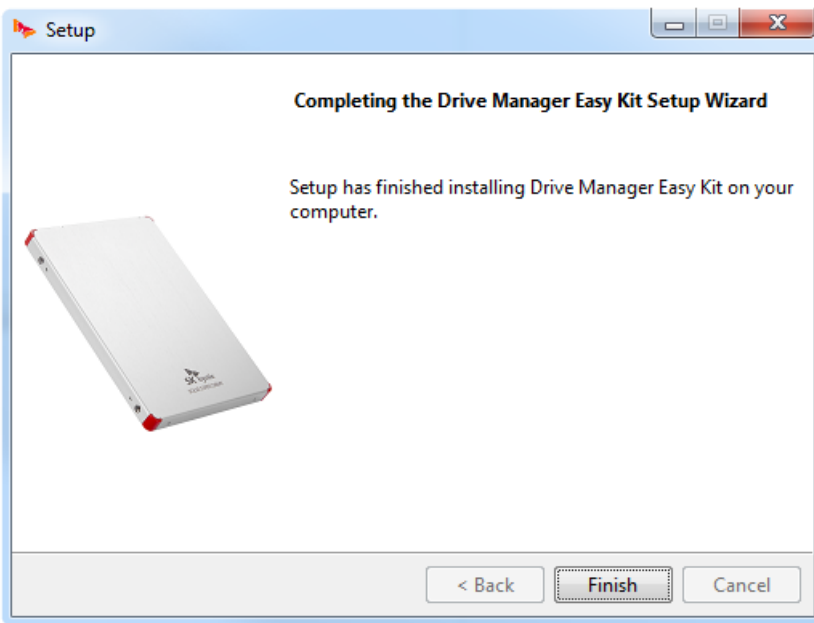


Figure 10 **Finish the Installation**

4 Launching SK hynix Drive Manager Easy Kit

To launch the program in CLI:

In the **command prompt window**, type one of the following (you need Administrator privileges):

- To launch CLI application, type `skhynix-drive`
- To launch GUI application, type `skhynix-drive-gui`


To launch help in CLI, run the following command: `skhynix-drive help`
or

To launch the program from the Start menu:

1. For Windows 7, 10:

In the **Start** menu, click **All programs**(Windows 7)/ **All Apps**(Windows 10), and then open the **SK hynix** folder.

For Windows 8, 12:

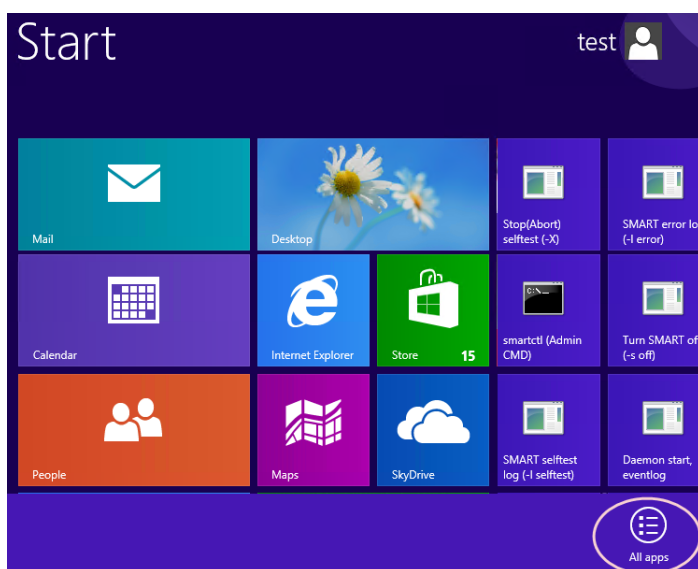
a. Press the Windows key  on your keyboard to open the **Start** screen.

b. To get the all **Apps** view:

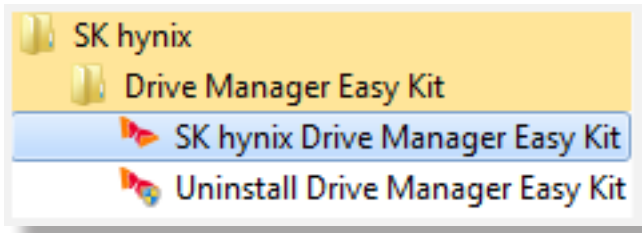
Click the arrow button
